You may even ask a parent, teacher, or friend to take a look at your work with "fresh eyes" for additional polish. If you'd like to submit work as a team, you may. Please limit your submission to **no more than one page**. Students may have parents help scribe their submissions. **Please remember to limit your submission to one written and/or one art entry.**

Written Submissions by EMAIL: If possible, email your written submission to goldandblue@gmail.com with your NAME and GRADE in the subject line. Please include "with ART" if the student has an art submission to accompany the written submission.

If handwriting your submission, pick up a Written Submission form from the office and place your completed entry in the GBCT box.

Art Submissions: Use ONLY a black marker. Fine or medium felt markers work best. Make sure it isn't 'fuzzy' or 'dry' so your artwork will look its best! PLEASE ERASE ALL 'STRAY' PENCIL LINES!!! You may scan and email your entry to goldandblue@gmail.com with your NAME and GRADE in the subject line or you may deposit your form in the GBCT box.

Dual Submissions (submissions with both a written and an art component): Please follow the above directions for a Written Submission and an Art Submission. Indicate on the art form whether your written submission will be submitted by email or in the GBCT box.

Entries not being emailed may be placed in GBCT box by the fish tank in the front hallway.

Entries will be accepted from February 6 to 24.
